(4) A violation of this section is a noncriminal 25 traffic infraction, punishable pursuant to chapter 318 as 26 27 either a moving violation for infractions of subsection (1), 28 subsection (2), or paragraph (a) of subsection (3), or as a 29 nonmoving violation for infractions of paragraphs (b) or (c) 30 of subsection (3). 31
