25	(a) The disabled parking permit is a placard that can
26	be placed in a motor vehicle so as to be visible from the
27	front and rear of the vehicle. Each side of the placard must
28	have the international symbol of accessibility in a
29	contrasting color in the center so as to be visible. One side
30	of the placard must display the applicant's driver's license
31	number or state identification card number along with a

warning that the applicant must have such identification at all times while using the parking permit. A validation sticker must also be issued with each disabled parking permit, showing the month and year of expiration on each side of the placard. Validation stickers must be of the size specified by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles and must be affixed to the disabled parking permits. The disabled parking permits must use the same colors as license plate validations.

- (b) License plates issued under ss. 320.084, 320.0842, 320.0843, and 320.0845 are valid for the same parking privileges and other privileges provided under ss. 316.1955, 316.1964, and 526.141(5)(a).
- (c) The administrative processing fee for each initial 4-year disabled parking permit or renewal permit shall be \$1.50, and all proceeds of that fee shall be retained by the tax collector of the county in which the fee was collected.

(c)1. Except as provided in subparagraph 2., the fee for a disabled parking permit shall be:

- a. Fifteen dollars for each initial 4-year permit or renewal permit, of which the State Transportation Trust Fund shall receive \$13.50 and the tax collector of the county in which the fee was collected shall receive \$1.50.
- b. One dollar for each additional or additional renewal 4-year permit, of which the State Transportation Trust Fund shall receive all funds collected.
- $\underline{(d)}$ The department shall not issue an additional disabled parking permit unless the applicant states that <u>he or she is they are</u> a frequent traveler or a quadriplegic. The department may not issue to any one eligible applicant more than two disabled parking permits except to an organization in accordance with paragraph (1)(e). Subsections (1), (5), (6),

and (7) apply to this subsection. 1 2 (e) $\frac{2}{3}$. If an applicant who is a disabled veteran, is a 3 resident of this state, has been honorably discharged, and 4 either has been determined by the Department of Defense or the 5 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or its predecessor to have a service-connected disability rating for 6 7 compensation of 50 percent or greater or has been determined to have a service-connected disability rating of 50 percent or 8 greater and is in receipt of both disability retirement pay 9 10 from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs, he or 11 she must still provide and has a signed physician's statement 12 of qualification for the disabled parking permits., the fee 13 for a disabled parking permit shall be: 14 a.
