(1) The Digital Divide Trust Fund is 13 created in the State Technology Office for the purpose of 14 receiving and disbursing funds required to pay part or all of 15 the costs of facilitating design and implementation of one or more programs using information technology to educate and 16 train members of economically disadvantaged families to become 17 18 qualified to compete effectively for high-skill, high-wage 19 employment opportunities in this state. The trust fund shall 20 be administered by the Digital Divide Council in the State Technology Office. 21 22 (2) The Digital Divide Trust Fund may receive funding 23 lawfully made from other sources, including, but not limited to, appropriations from the state and gifts, donations, and 24 25 matching contributions from other public agencies and private 26 persons and entities. 27 Section 2. Under Section 19(f)(2), Article III of the State Constitution, the Digital Divide Trust Fund is 28 29 terminated July 1, 2006, unless terminated sooner. Before its 30 scheduled termination, the trust fund must be reviewed as

provided in section 215.3206(1) and (2), Florida Statutes.
