Law Enforcement Agency Consolidation Study 26 Commission.--27 (1)(a) There is created within the Executive Office of the Governor the Law Enforcement Agency Consolidation Study 28 29 Commission. The commission shall be composed of: 30 31

The Attorney General or his or her designee; A member of the Senate, appointed by the President A member of the House of Representatives, appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The Executive Office of the Governor shall provide staff support for the commission. The commission shall select

11 a chairperson from among its members. 12 (2)(a) The commission shall meet for the purpose of studying the effects of consolidating the law enforcement 13

agencies in this state under a unified command. The commission 14 shall submit an initial report of its findings and 15

recommendations to the Governor, the President of the Senate, 16

17 and the Speaker of the House of Representatives by March 1,

2003. The commission may file additional reports or 18 19 recommendations as are necessary in carrying out its duties. Members of the commission shall not receive 20 (b)

21 compensation other than the salaries received in the course of

their employment, but the members are entitled to 22

reimbursement for per diem and travel expenses in accordance 23

with section 112.061, Florida Statutes. 24

(3) The commission shall: 25

(a) Require each state department, division, or agency 26

27 to submit a report to the commission on the number of

positions within that department, division, or agency which 28

29 are positions for sworn law enforcement personnel and identify

30 any section of the Florida Statutes upon which the department,

31 division, or agency relies for authority to employ the sworn

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1 law enforcement personnel. The report must be submitted to the commission by October 1, 2002. 2 3 (b) Prepare and submit a report to the Legislature 4 before the 2003 Regular Session which includes recommendations 5 for: б 1. Proposed legislation to revise the Florida Statutes 7 to reflect the consolidation of all positions for sworn law 8 enforcement personnel within the Department of Law Enforcement. The commission may consult with any state agency 9 10 in preparing proposed legislation and may direct the Division 11 of Statutory Revision of the Office of Legislative Services to assist the commission in identifying relevant sections of the 12 13 Florida Statutes. 2. Changes within any affected department, division, 14 15 or agency to reduce administrators and management personnel and save expenses as a result of consolidation. 16 17 3. Repeals of Florida Statutes to reflect any 18 consolidation of positions for sworn law enforcement 19 personnel. 4. Changes within the Department of Law Enforcement to 20 reflect the proposed consolidation. Any recommendation may 21 include the creation of new divisions or the restructuring of 22 divisions within the department and any recommended 23 24 legislation. (4) In addition to any other affected department, 25 division, or agency, the commission shall make recommendations 26 27 for consolidating and restructuring the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, the Department of 28 Environmental Protection, the Division of Alcoholic Beverages 29 30 and Tobacco within the Department of Business and Professional 31 Regulation, the Department of Highway Safety and Motor

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Vehicles, the Division of Insurance Fraud within the 1 Department of Insurance, the Florida Capitol Police within the 2 3 Department of Management Services, the Office of Motor Carrier Compliance within the Department of Transportation, the Bureau 4 5 of Fire Investigation within the Division of State Fire б Marshal of the Department of Insurance, the Fish and Wildlife 7 Conservation Commission, the Florida Agricultural and 8 Mechanical University Police, the Florida Atlantic University Police Department, the Florida Gulf Coast University Campus 9 10 Police and Safety, the Florida International University Public 11 Safety Department, the University Police Department of Florida State University, the Pensacola Junior College Police 12 Department, the Santa Fe Community College Police Department, 13 the University of Central Florida University Police 14 Department, the University of Florida University Police 15 Department, the University of North Florida University Police 16 17 Department, the University of South Florida Campus Police Department, the University of West Florida Police Department, 18 19 the Division of Blind Services within the Department of Education, the parks police of the Division of Recreation and 20 Parks within the Department of Environmental Protection, and 21 all medical officers within the Agency for Health Care 22 Administration who are sworn law enforcement officers. 23 24 (5) The commission is abolished July 1, 2003. 25 Section 2.
