A bill to be entitled

An act relating to enterprise zone designation; requiring designation of an enterprise zone in the City of Hialeah under certain circumstances notwithstanding certain limitations; providing requirements; prohibiting a racetrack or pari-mutuel facility from providing the basis for benefits or incentives due to its location within an enterprise zone; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the limitation in section 290.0065, Florida Statutes, on numbers of enterprise zones within a population category, the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development shall designate, upon joint application by Miami-Dade County and the City of Hialeah, an area within the municipality of the City of Hialeah in an area bounded by 32nd Street, 21st Street, Palm Avenue, and East 4th Avenue as an enterprise zone. The application must be submitted by June 1, 2002, and must comply with the requirements of section 290.0055, Florida Statutes, except for paragraph (4)(d). The effective date of the enterprise zone is July 1, 2002.

Section 2. <u>Limitation of enterprise zone benefits and incentives to pari-mutuels.--No person located in an area for which a permit or license has been issued authorizing pari-mutuel operations may receive benefits or incentives due to the person's location within an enterprise zone.</u>
