The trust fund is exempt from the 4 service charges imposed by s. 215.20. 5 (2) The Public Employee Optional Retirement Program Clearing Trust Fund is a retirement clearing trust fund of the 6 7 Florida Retirement System that accounts for retirement plan 8 assets held by the state in a trustee capacity as a fiduciary 9 for individual participants in the Public Employee Optional Retirement Program and, pursuant to s. 19(f), Art. III of the 10 11 State Constitution, is not subject to termination. Section 2.
