- (b) A person who commits lewd or lascivious molestation of an elderly person or disabled <u>person</u> adult commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.
- (4)(a) "Lewd or lascivious exhibition in the presence of an elderly person or disabled <u>person</u> adult" occurs when a person, in the presence of an elderly person or disabled person adult:
  - 1. Intentionally masturbates;
- 2. Intentionally exposes his or her genitals in a lewd or lascivious manner; or
- 3. Intentionally commits any other lewd or lascivious act that does not involve actual physical or sexual contact with the elderly person or disabled <a href="mailto:person">person</a> adult, including but not limited to, sadomasochistic abuse, sexual bestiality, or the simulation of any act involving sexual activity,
