If the product is again found in violation, the 18 19 department shall test or examine the product for a third time 20 within 60 days after the second notification. The product manufacturer shall reimburse the department for the cost of 21 2.2 the third test or examination. If the product is found in 23 violation for a third time, the department shall exercise its 24 authority under s. 500.172 and issue a stop-sale or stop-use 25 order. The department may impose additional sanctions for 26 violations of this subsection. 27 Section 2.
