I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund, FLAIR number 62-2-719. The Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund is administered by the Department of Military Affairs. The effective date is November 4, 2004.

II. SUBSTANTIVE ANALYSIS:

A. PRESENT SITUATION:

1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

Section 250.175, F.S., created the Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund.

2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

Re-creating the Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund enables the department to receive, spend and account for receipts and revenues from: federal criminal, administrative and civil forfeiture proceedings, and federal asset-sharing programs. Federal law requires state law enforcement agencies to establish and maintain separate accounts for these types of federal receipts and revenues.

In the 2001-2002 fiscal year, the Legislature appropriated \$798,000.

3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:
