"Department" means the Department of State. 11 (b) 12 (C) "Materials and records" includes, but is not 13 limited to databases, source or object codes, and any software relating to the Florida Secured Transaction Registry or other 14 15 filing system for centralized filing under this chapter, regardless of the original source of its creation or 16 17 maintenance. 18 (2) Under chapter 287, the department has the 19 authority to determine and select the most qualified 20 respondents to the request for qualifications and to negotiate 21 and enter into one or more contracts as provided in this 22 section. The contract may not be assignable or otherwise 23 transferable without the express written consent of the 24 department. (3) 25 The department shall perform the duties, as filing officer and filing office under this chapter, for the Florida 26 27 Secured Transaction Registry until October 1, 2001, or until the effective date of a contract executed by the department to 28 29 administer and operate the registry for the performance of these duties, whichever occurs later.
