I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Juvenile Crime Prevention and Early Intervention Trust Fund, FLAIR number 802415, without modification. The Juvenile Crime Prevention and Early Intervention Trust Fund is administered by the Department of Juvenile Justice.

II. SUBSTANTIVE ANALYSIS:

A. PRESENT SITUATION:

1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

Chapter 94-210, Laws of Florida, and section 320.08975, F.S., create the trust fund and provide for its purpose.

2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The department uses proceeds of the fee from "Invest in Children" license plates to fund programs and services that are designed to prevent juvenile delinquency.

For the 2001-2002 fiscal year, the Legislature appropriated \$1,502,000.

3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The primary source of revenue for the Juvenile Crime Prevention and Early Intervention Trust Fund is the "Invest in Children" license plate annual use fee. Total receipts from these funds for the 2000-2001 year were \$638,046. Agency estimates for the 2001-2002 fiscal year and the 2002-2003 fiscal year are \$638,046 and \$638,046, respectively.

B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.

III. FISCAL ANALYSIS & ECONOMIC IMPACT STATEMENT:

This legislation has no fiscal impact on state agencies or state funds, on local governments as a whole or on the private sector. It simply re-creates, without modification, an existing state trust fund and continues the current use of the fund.
