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I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Social Services Block Grant Trust Fund, FLAIR number 80-2639, without modification. The Social Services Block Grant Trust Fund is administered by the Department of Juvenile Justice.

II. SUBSTANTIVE ANALYSIS:

A. PRESENT SITUATION:

1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

The trust fund is not in statute.

2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The trust fund captures revenue and expenditures for earnings related to the Social Services Block Grant.

For the 2001-2002 fiscal year, the Legislature appropriated \$49,823,448.

3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The Social Services Block Grant derives revenue from the United States Department of Health and Human Services through the Florida Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services.

Total receipts from these funds for the 2000-2001 year were \$48,003,173. Agency estimates for the 2001-2002 fiscal year and the 2002-2003 fiscal year are \$47,540,541 and \$47,540,541, respectively.

B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.

III. FISCAL ANALYSIS & ECONOMIC IMPACT STATEMENT:

This legislation has no fiscal impact on state agencies or state funds, on local governments as a whole or on the private sector. It simply re-creates, without modification, an existing state trust fund and continues the current use of the fund.
