| 9  | Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:      |

| 11 | Section 1. If an individual files a complaint against          |
| 12 | a law enforcement officer or law enforcement agency, or both,  |
| 13 | alleging racial profiling, which is defined by the Florida     |
| 14 | Department of Law Enforcement as "unequal treatment of any     |
| 15 | person including stopping, questioning, searching, detention,  |
| 16 | or arrest solely or primarily on the basis of their racial or  |
| 17 | ethnic characteristics, religion, gender, sexual orientation   |
| 18 | or socio-economic status," the Attorney General may respond to |
| 19 | the complaint by taking one or more of the following steps:    |
| 20 | (1) Sending a written inquiry to the appropriate law           |
| 21 | enforcement agency regarding the allegation and requesting a   |
| 22 | written response or internal investigation, or both, of the    |
| 23 | alleged incident of racial profiling.                          |
| 24 | (2) Initiating an investigation or policy review of            |
| 25 | the named law enforcement agency within the Office of the      |
| 26 | Attorney General.  |
| 27 | (3) Referring the inquiry to the Criminal Justice              |
| 28 | Standards and Training Commission for a policy review of the   |
| 29 | law enforcement agency or to a local prosecutor to conduct a   |
| 30 | criminal investigation.  |
| 31 | Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2002.            |
