The Caribbean 2 3 Conservation Corporation shall annually distribute assigned funds through a Sea Turtle Grants Program that supports sea 4 5 turtle research and education activities of Florida-based 6 nonprofit groups, educational institutions, and coastal 7 counties. The Caribbean Conservation Corporation shall write 8 and publish procedures for submitting grant applications and criteria for allocating available funds, and shall appoint a 9 technical advisory committee, composed of at least five 10 11 members, including two representatives from the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, to select grant recipients 12 from proposals submitted by eliqible entities. Any additional 13 annual revenue shall be distributed as follows: 70 percent 14 shall be deposited in the Marine Resources Conservation Trust 15 Fund and used by the Florida Marine Turtle Protection Program 16 17 for sea turtle conservation activities; 30 percent shall be 18 assigned to the Caribbean Conservation Corporation for 19 distribution through the Sea Turtle Grants Program. The remaining annual use proceeds 29 shall be used by the Florida Marine Turtle Protection Program 30 for sea turtle conservation activities.

Section 3. Paragraph (h) of subsection (1) of section 370.12, Florida Statutes, is repealed. Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2002. SENATE SUMMARY Repeals provisions that authorize the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission to distribute grant money out of certain proceeds from the sale of Sea Turtle license plates and provides for the distribution of such funds to the Caribbean Conservation Corporation. Provides guidelines for the corporation to distribute such funds. Increases the annual use fees for the plates. (See bill for details.)
