Section 1. Paragraphs (hh) and (ii) are added to subsection (4) of section 320.08056 , Florida Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 2001-355, Laws of Florida, to read:

(4) The following license plate annual use fees shall be collected for the appropriate specialty license plates:
(hh) Florida Firefighters license plate, \$20. (ii) Police Benevolent Association license plate, \$20. Section 2. (3) COLLEGIATE LICENSE PLATES.--
(a) The department shall develop a collegiate license plate as provided in this section for state and independent universities domiciled in this state. However, any collegiate license plate created or established after October 1, 2002, January 1, 1997,must comply with the requirements of $s$. 320.08053 and be specifically authorized by an act of the Legislature. Collegiate license plates must bear the colors and design approved by the department as appropriate for each state and independent university. The word "Florida" must be stamped across the bottom of the plate in small letters.
(b) A collegiate plate annual use fee is to be distributed to the state or independent university foundation designated by the purchaser for deposit in an unrestricted account.
