The department shall issue a decal and registration 20 certificate, to be renewed annually, reflecting the HOV lane designation on inherently low-emission vehicles authorizing 21 2.2 such use. The department may charge a fee for the decals, at a price not to exceed the costs of designing, producing, and 23 24 distributing each decal, or \$5, whichever is less. The 25 proceeds from sale of the decals shall be deposited in the Highway Safety Operating Trust Fund. 26 27 (5) The department has specific authority to 28 promulgate rules addressing the design, production, and 29 distribution of the decals described in subsection (4); the enforcement of ILEV use of HOV lanes; and the purchase and 30 renewal of such decals. 31
