SENATE SUMMARY Provides for a student to be released to the custody of a parent or legal guardian if the student has committed an offense that subjects the student to suspension or expulsion. If the student cannot be released to a parent or guardian, requires that the student be placed in in-school suspension or detention until the end of the school day. Requires that the student be released to the custody of a law enforcement agency if the student has committed a violent act. б
