An act relating to child support; creating s.
61.13005, F.S.; prohibiting entry or
enforcement of an order of child support in
certain cases when DNA testing indicates that
the person against whom the order is sought is
not the child's parent; providing an effective
date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 61.13005, Florida Statutes, is
created to read:

61.13005 Child support proceedings; DNA testing.--In
any proceeding in which liability for child support is at
issue, an order imposing such liability may not be entered or
enforced when the results of DNA testing indicate that the
person against whom the order is sought is not the child's
parent, unless that person has adopted the child.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2002.

SENATE SUMMARY

Prohibits entry or enforcement of an order of child
support when DNA tests indicate that the person against
whom the order is sought is not the child's parent,
unless that person has adopted the child.
