On the effective date of this act, the City of Coconut Creek shall be responsible for and embodied with all municipal powers granted in chapter 166, Florida Statutes, over territory hereby annexed. Section 3. Nothing in this act shall be construed to affect or abrogate the rights of parties to any contracts, whether the same be between Broward County and a third party or between nongovernmental entities, which contracts are in effect prior to the effective date of annexation. Section 4. This act shall take effect September 15, 2002.
