28	to have a service-connected total and permanent disability
29	rating of 100 percent and are in receipt of disability

A certified copy of a death certificate, a valid 4 identification card issued in accordance with the provisions of s. 295.17, a letter certifying the service-connected 5 6 100-percent total and permanent disability rating for 7 compensation from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs, or a letter certifying the service-connected total 8 9 and permanent disability rating of 100 percent for retirement 10 pay from any branch of the United States Armed Services is prima facie evidence that the dependent children of such 11 12 military personnel are eligible for educational benefits.
