The estimate will be submitted to the Executive Office of the Governor, the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House on August 1 of each year.

- (3) Each fiscal year, any funding increases for crisis services or community mental health services that are included in the General Appropriations Act shall be appropriated in a Lump-Sum" category as defined in section 216.011(1)(aa), Florida Statutes. In accordance with section 216.181(6)(a), Florida Statutes, the Executive Office of the Governor shall require the Department of Children and Family Services to submit a spending plan for the use of funds appropriated for this purpose. The spending plan must include a schedule for phasing-in the new community mental health services in each service district of the department and must describe how the new services will be integrated and coordinated with all current community-based health and human services.
- (4) On October 1, 2002, and on October 1, 2003, the

 Department of Children and Family Services shall submit a

 report to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the

 Speaker of the House of Representatives concerning the

 progress made toward expanding the provision of community
