- (3) All conveyances or vehicles, fuel tanks, related fuel, and other equipment described in section (1) shall be subject to seizure and forfeiture, as provided by the Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act.
- (4) The law enforcement agency that seized the motor or diesel fuel, under this section, shall remove and reclaim, recycle, or dispose of all associated motor or diesel fuel as soon as practical in a safe and proper manner from illegal containers.
- (5) Upon conviction of the person arrested for the violation of any of the provisions, the judge shall issue an order adjudging and declaring that all fuel tanks and other equipment used in violation of this section shall be forfeited, and directing its destruction, with the exception of the conveyance of vehicle.
- (6) Any person convicted under this section, shall be responsible for:
- (a) all reasonable costs, incurred by the investigating law enforcement agency, including the towing and storage of the conveyance or vehicle, and the removal and disposal of the motor or diesel fuel, and the storage and destruction of all
