1 House Resolution A resolution paying tribute to the memory of 2 3 Sgt. Bradley Crose. 4 WHEREAS, described by his father as a devout Christian, 5 and possessed of a reputation for being fiercely principled, б 7 Orange Park native son Bradley Crose graduated from high school in 1998 and, determined to fulfill his dream of 8 9 "jumping from airplanes," joined the United States Army, quickly rising to the rank of sergeant, and 10 WHEREAS, Sgt. Bradley Crose proved to be an exceptional 11 Army Ranger and was assigned to the 1st Battalion, 75th Ranger 12 Regiment, of Savannah, Georgia, a highly trained special 13 14 operations group prepared for deployment anywhere in the world 15 on 18 hours' notice, and WHEREAS, on March 4, 2002, Sgt. Bradley Crose, 22, was 16 in command of a six-member fire team, part of a helicopter 17 rescue team in Afghanistan sent to retrieve the body of a Navy 18 19 SEAL who had been killed in combat, and 20 WHEREAS, on March 4, 2002, Sqt. Bradley Crose was one of six United States soldiers who died in the snow-capped 21 2.2 mountains of east Afghanistan, the result of enemy fire, and 23 WHEREAS, on March 11, 2002, six months after the tragic 24 events that sent Sgt. Bradley Crose to his death on foreign 25 soil, thousands of silent, flag-carrying mourners lined the streets of Orange Park in their last tribute to a fallen 26 27 warrior as his funeral procession made its way from Pinewood Presbyterian Church to Jacksonville Memory Gardens, where he 28 29 was laid to rest, and WHEREAS, in his life, Sgt. Bradley Crose set a standard 30 of incredible moral courage, and, in his death, he became an 31 1
