The 16 17 corporation may accumulate and maintain in the operating fund at any given time a cash balance equal to no more than 25 18 19 percent of annualized operating expenses. Upon the dissolution 20 of the corporation, any remaining cash balances of state funds shall revert to the state General Revenue Fund. 21 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2002. 23 24 25 SENATE SUMMARY Allows the Florida Healthy Kids Corporation to establish and manage an operating fund in the amount of 25 percent or less of annualized operating expenses.
