Paragraph (b) of subsection (3) of section 311.07, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 15 16 311.07 Florida seaport transportation and economic 17 development funding .--(3) 18 19 (b) Projects eligible for funding by grants under the 20 program are limited to the following port facilities or port 21 transportation projects: 22 Transportation facilities within the jurisdiction 23 of the port. 24 The dredging or deepening of channels, turning 25 basins, or harbors. The construction or rehabilitation of wharves, 26 27 docks, structures, jetties, piers, storage facilities, cruise 28 terminals, automated people mover systems, or any facilities 29 necessary or useful in connection with any of the foregoing. 30 31

- 4. The acquisition of container cranes or other mechanized equipment used in the movement of cargo or passengers in international commerce.
- 5. The acquisition of land to be used for port purposes.
- 6. The acquisition, improvement, enlargement, or extension of existing port facilities.
- 7. Environmental protection projects which are necessary because of requirements imposed by a state agency as a condition of a permit or other form of state approval; which are necessary for environmental mitigation required as a condition of a state, federal, or local environmental permit; which are necessary for the acquisition of spoil disposal sites and improvements to existing and future spoil sites; or which result from the funding of eligible projects listed in this paragraph herein.
- 8. Transportation facilities as defined in s. 334.03(31) which are not otherwise part of the Department of Transportation's adopted work program.
- 9. Seaport intermodal access projects identified in the 5-year Florida Seaport Mission Plan as provided in s. 311.09(3).
- 10. Construction or rehabilitation of port facilities as defined in s. 315.02, excluding any park or recreational facilities, in ports listed in s. 311.09(1) with operating revenues of \$5 million or less, provided that such projects create economic development opportunities, capital improvements, and positive financial returns to such ports.
- 11. Seaport security infrastructure measures. Such measures include security gates, physical barriers, and security-related lighting systems, equipment, or facilities to

be used for seaport security monitoring and recording, remote surveillance systems, concealed recording systems, or other security infrastructure or equipment that contributes to the overall security of the seaport and its facilities. Seaport security infrastructure measures are not subject to the matching fund requirements of paragraph (a). Any federal funds that are provided for port security infrastructure improvements of which funds seaports in this state are the beneficiaries must first be used to reimburse the state seaport transportation and economic development funding provided by this state under subparagraph 11. These reimbursed funds must be used for projects and measures authorized under subparagraphs 1.-10. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2002. SENATE SUMMARY Adds seaport security infrastructure measures to the list of projects eligible for funding by grant under the Florida Seaport Transportation and Economic Development Program and exempts such measures from matching fund requirements.
