The identity of a donor or prospective donor to the 6 Florida Alzheimer's Center and Research Institute who desires 7 to remain anonymous and all information identifying such donor 8 or prospective donor; 5. Any information received by the Institute in the 9 10 performance of its duties and responsibilities which is 11 otherwise confidential and exempt by law; and 12 6. Any information received by the Institute from a 13 person from another state or nation or the federal government 14 which is otherwise confidential or exempt pursuant to that 15 state's or nation's laws or pursuant to federal law. 16 17 Any governmental entity that demonstrates a need to access 18 such confidential and exempt information in order to perform 19 its duties and responsibilities shall have access to such information and shall otherwise keep such information 20 confidential and exempt. This section is subject to the Open 21 Government Sunset Review Act of 1995 in accordance with 22 section 119.15, Florida Statutes, and shall stand repealed on 23 24 October 2, 2006, unless reviewed and saved from repeal through 25 reenactment by the Legislature. Section 2. The Legislature finds that is a public 26 27 necessity that personal, medical, or health information about clients or patients that is created or received by the Florida 28 29 Alzheimer's Center and Research Institute be made confidential 30 and exempt from public disclosure because access to such personal, medical, or health information about clients or 31 2

patients of the Florida Alzheimer's Center and Research 1 2 Institute would be an unwarranted invasion of a client's or 3 patient's right to privacy and that the misuse of such 4 sensitive personal, medical, or health information could be detrimental to the health, safety, or welfare of the client or 5 patient. The Legislature finds that it is a public necessity 6 7 that information regarding materials that relate to methods of manufacture or production, potential trade secrets, potential 8 patentable material, actual trade secrets, business 9 10 transactions, or proprietary information received, generated, 11 ascertained, or discovered during the course of research 12 conducted through the Florida Alzheimer's Center and Research 13 Institute be made confidential and exempt from public disclosure because the disclosure of such information would 14 15 impede the effective and efficient operation of the Florida Alzheimer's Center and Research Institute and would create an 16 17 unfair competitive advantage for persons or entities receiving 18 such information. The Legislature further finds that it is a public necessity that information regarding donors or 19 prospective donors to the Florida Alzheimer's Center and 20 Research Institute who wish to remain anonymous remain 21 confidential and exempt from public disclosure because the 22 disclosure of such information would have a chilling effect on 23 24 the efforts of the Florida Alzheimer's Center and Research 25 Institute to solicit such donations as the donors or prospective donors would be publicly identified against their 26 27 wishes. Any information shared with the Institute by others not subject to this state's laws which is otherwise 28 29 confidential or exempt must also not be disclosed because to 30 do otherwise would discourage others from sharing needed 31 information with the Institute which would impede the 3

Section This act shall take effect July 1, 3 2002, if HB 37-E or similar legislation is adopted in the same 4 legislative session or an extension thereof and becomes law. 5 6 7 And the title is amended as follows: 8 9 On page 1, lines 3 through 16, 10 remove: all of said lines 11 12 and insert: certain information held by the Florida 13 Alzheimer's Center and Research Institute and 14 15 others, creating an exemption from the public records provisions of the Florida Constitution 16 17 and Florida law for certain information relating to clients and patients and donors as 18 well as medical and health records, and certain 19 20 proprietary and trade secret information; providing a statement of public necessity for 21 such exemptions; providing for future repeal; 22 providing a contingent effective date. 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 4
