(c) Any term used in this code shall have the same meaning as when used in a comparable context in the Internal Revenue Code and other statutes of the United States relating to federal income taxes, as such code and statutes are in effect on January 1, 2002 2001. However, if subsection (3) is implemented, the meaning of any term shall be taken at the time the term is applied under this code.

Section 3. If any law amended by this act was also amended by a law enacted during the 2002 Regular Session of the Legislature, such laws shall be construed to have been enacted during the same session of the Legislature and full effect shall be given to each if possible.

Section 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law and shall operate retroactively to January 1, 2002.

HOUSE SUMMARY
