39.905 Domestic violence centers.--

(7)(a) All funds collected and appropriated to the domestic violence program for certified domestic violence centers shall be distributed annually by the department to each district according to an allocation formula approved determined by the department. In developing the formula, the factors of department shall consider population, a rural and geographical area factor, and the incidence of domestic violence shall be considered.
