Section 1. Section 316.2015, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

18 316.2015 Unlawful for person to ride on exterior of vehicle.--

- vehicle to permit any person to ride on the bumper, radiator, fender, hood, top, trunk, or running board of such vehicle when operated upon any street or highway which is maintained by the state, county or municipality. However, the operator of any vehicle shall not be in violation of this section when such operator permits any person to occupy seats securely affixed to the exterior of such vehicle. Any person who violates the provisions of this subsection shall be cited for a moving violation, punishable as provided in chapter 318.
- (2) No person shall ride on any vehicle upon any portion thereof not designed or intended for the use of

passengers. This provision shall not apply to an employee of a 2 fire department, a governmentally operated solid waste 3 disposal department, or a waste disposal service operating pursuant to a contract with a governmental entity or to a 4 5 volunteer firefighter engaged in the necessary discharge of a 6 duty, nor does it apply to a person who is being transported 7 in response to an emergency by a public agency or pursuant to 8 the direction or authority of a public agency or to a person 9 or persons riding within truck bodies in space intended for 10 merchandise. No minor child 16 years of age or younger shall 11 ride upon the public roads of the state within the body of an open pickup truck or flatbed truck unless the minor is 12 restrained within the back of a truck which has been modified 13 to include secure seating and safety restraints which would 14 prevent the minor from being thrown, falling, or jumping from 15 the truck. The provisions of this subsection shall be 16 17 inapplicable in a medical emergency if the child is accompanied within the truck by an adult and shall be 18 19 inapplicable when the truck is being operated upon a farm or off the public roads of the state. Any person who violates the 20 21 provisions of this subsection shall be cited for a nonmoving violation, punishable as provided in chapter 318. 22 23

(3) This section shall not apply to a performer engaged in a professional exhibition or person participating in an exhibition or parade, or any such person preparing to participate in such exhibitions or parades.

Section 2. Subsection (7) is added to section 316.008, Florida Statutes, to read:

316.008 Powers of local authorities.--

(7) A county or municipality may adopt an ordinance that authorizes persons to ride on the bed of a pickup truck
