A bill to be entitled

An act relating to enterprise zones; amending s. 290.0065, F.S.; extending the date for submission of applications for enterprise zone boundary changes; amending s. 290.00693, F.S.; providing that the governing body of Gadsden County may apply to the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development to amend the boundaries of a specified enterprise zone; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (11) of section 290.0065, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

290.0065 State designation of enterprise zones.--

(11) Before June 1, 2004 2002, the governing body of a municipality that is located within a county having a population of less than 225,000 and in which an enterprise zone designated under subparagraph (3)(a)2. is located may apply to the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development to change the boundaries of the enterprise zone. The Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development shall approve the application if the boundary change does not increase the overall size of the enterprise zone and if any territory added to the enterprise zone as a result of the boundary change is contiguous to the remaining area of the existing enterprise zone.

Section 2. Section 290.00693, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

290.00693 Enterprise zone designation for Gadsden County.
- (1) Gadsden County may apply to the Office of Tourism,

Trade, and Economic Development for designation of one

enterprise zone encompassing an area within the county. The application must be submitted by December 31, 1999, and must comply with the requirements of s. 290.0055. Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 290.0065 limiting the total number of enterprise zones designated and the number of enterprise zones within a population category, the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development may designate one enterprise zone under this section. The Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development shall establish the initial effective date of the enterprise zone designated pursuant to this section.

- (2) Before December 31, 2003, the governing body of a county in which an enterprise zone designated pursuant to this section is located may apply to the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development to amend the boundaries of the enterprise zone for the purpose of replacing areas not suitable for development
 - Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
