Section 402.310, Florida Statutes, is 18 19 amended to read: 20 402.310 Disciplinary actions; hearings upon denial, 21 suspension, or revocation of license; administrative fines.--22 (1)(a) The department or local licensing agency may 23 deny, suspend, or revoke a license of a child care facility, a licensed family day care home, or a large family child care 24 25 home or the registration of a family day care home, or may impose an administrative fine not to exceed \$100 per 26 27 violation, per day, for the violation of any provision of ss. 28 402.301-402.319 or rules adopted thereunder. However, where 29 the violation could or does cause death or serious harm, the 30 department or local licensing agency may impose an administrative fine, not to exceed \$500 per violation per day. 31 1

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1 (b) In determining the appropriate disciplinary action 2 to be taken for a violation as provided in paragraph (a), the 3 following factors shall be considered: The severity of the violation, including the 4 1. 5 probability that death or serious harm to the health or safety б of any person will result or has resulted, the severity of the 7 actual or potential harm, and the extent to which the 8 provisions of ss. 402.301-402.319 have been violated. 9 2. Actions taken by the licensee or registrant to 10 correct the violation or to remedy complaints. 11 3. Any previous violations of the licensee. (2) When the department has reasonable cause to 12 believe that grounds for the denial, suspension, or revocation 13 of a license or registration or imposition of an 14 administrative fine exist, it shall determine the matter in 15 accordance with procedures prescribed in chapter 120. 16 When 17 the local licensing agency has reasonable cause to believe that grounds for the denial, suspension, or revocation of a 18 19 license or registration or imposition of an administrative fine exist, it shall notify the applicant, registrant, or 20 licensee in writing, stating the grounds upon which the 21 license or registration is being denied, suspended, or revoked 22 or an administrative fine is being imposed. If the applicant, 23 24 registrant, or licensee makes no written request for a hearing 25 to the local licensing agency within 15 days after from receipt of such notice, the license or registration shall be 26 deemed denied, suspended, or revoked or an administrative fine 27 28 shall be imposed. 29 (3) If a request for a hearing is made to the local 30 licensing agency, a hearing shall be held within 30 days and 31

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1 shall be conducted by an individual designated by the county 2 commission. 3 (4) An applicant, registrant, or licensee shall have 4 the right to appeal a decision of the local licensing agency 5 to a representative of the department. Any required hearing б shall be held in the county in which the child care facility 7 is being operated or is to be established. The hearing shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions of chapter 120. 8 9 Section 2. Subsection (10) of section 402.313, Florida 10 Statutes, is amended to read: 402.313 Family day care homes.--11 (10) The department shall, by rule, establish minimum 12 13 standards for family day care homes that are required to be 14 licensed by county licensing ordinance or county licensing 15 resolution or that voluntarily choose to be licensed. The standards should include requirements for staffing, training, 16 17 maintenance of immunization records, minimum health and safety standards, reduced standards for the regulation of child care 18 19 during evening hours by municipalities and counties, and enforcement of standards. 20 Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 21 22 law. 23 24 25 SENATE SUMMARY Authorizes the Department of Children and Family Services or a local licensing agency to deny, suspend, or revoke the license of a child care facility, a licensed family day care home, or a large family child care home and to deny, suspend, or revoke the registration of a family day care home following a violation of laws or rules governing the operation of such homes or facilities.
