Present subsection (8) of section 409.1451, 11 12 Florida Statutes, is redesignated as subsection (9), and a new subsection (8) is added to that section to read: 13 409.1451 Independent living transition services.--14 15 (8) PROPERTY ACQUIRED ON BEHALF OF CLIENTS. -- Property acquired on behalf of a client receiving services under this 16 17 section shall be the personal property of the client and is not subject to the requirements of chapter 273 relating to 18 19 state-owned tangible personal property. Section 2.
