Paragraphs (c) and (d) of subsection (1) of section 893.13, Florida Statutes, are amended to read: 18 19 893.13 Prohibited acts; penalties.--20 (1)21 (c) Except as authorized by this chapter, it is 22 unlawful for any person to sell, manufacture, or deliver, or possess with intent to sell, manufacture, or deliver, a 23 controlled substance in, on, or within 1,000 feet of the real 24 25 property comprising a public park, a publicly owned community 26 center or recreational facility, a child care facility as 27 defined in s. 402.302, or a public or private elementary, 28 middle, or secondary school between the hours of 6 a.m. and 12 29 a.m. Any person who violates this paragraph with respect to: 30 1. A controlled substance named or described in s. 31 893.03(1)(a), (1)(b),(1)(d), (2)(a), (2)(b), or (2)(c)4., 1
