Paragraphs (c) and (d) of subsection (1) of 15 16 section 626.321, Florida Statutes, are amended to read: 626.321 Limited licenses.--17 (1) The department shall issue to a qualified 18 19 individual, or a qualified individual or entity under 20 paragraphs (c), (d), (e), and (i), a license as agent authorized to transact a limited class of business in any of 21 22 the following categories: (c) Personal accident insurance. -- License covering 23 only policies of personal accident insurance covering the 24 25 risks of travel, except as provided in subparagraph 2. 26 license may be issued only: 27 To a full-time salaried employee of a common 28 carrier or a full-time salaried employee or owner of a 29 transportation ticket agency and may authorize the sale of

such ticket policies only in connection with the sale of

of such an agent. No such policy shall be for a duration of more than 48 hours or for the duration of a specified one-way trip or round trip.

- To a full-time salaried employee of a business which offers motor vehicles for rent or lease, or to a business office of a business entity that which offers motor vehicles for rent or lease if insurance sales activities authorized by the license are in connection with and incidental to the rental of a motor vehicle limited to full-time salaried employees. A business entity office licensed or a person licensed pursuant to this subparagraph may, as an agent of an insurer, transact insurance that provides coverage for accidental personal injury or death of the lessee and any passenger who is riding or driving with the covered lessee in the rental motor vehicle if the lease or rental agreement is for not more than 90 30 days, or if the lessee is not provided coverage for more than 90 30 consecutive days per lease period; however, if the lease is extended beyond 90 30 days, the coverage may be extended one time only for a period not to exceed an additional 30 days.
- (d) Baggage and motor vehicle excess liability insurance.--
- 1. License covering only insurance of personal effects except as provided in subparagraph 2. The license may be issued only:
- a. To a full-time salaried employee of a common carrier or a full-time salaried employee or owner of a transportation ticket agency, which person is engaged in the sale or handling of transportation of baggage and personal effects of travelers, and may authorize the sale of such 31 insurance only in connection with such transportation; or

To the full-time salaried employee of a licensed general lines agent, a full-time salaried employee of a business which offers motor vehicles for rent or lease, or to a business entity that office of a business which offers motor vehicles for rent or lease if insurance sales activities authorized by the license are in connection with and incidental to the rental of a motor vehicle limited to full-time salaried employees.

The business entity offering purchaser of baggage insurance shall make available be provided written information disclosing that states that the insured's homeowner's policy may provide coverage for loss of personal effects and that the purchase of such insurance is not required in connection with the purchase of tickets or in connection with the lease or rental of a motor vehicle.

2. A business entity that office licensed pursuant to subparagraph 1., or a person licensed pursuant to subparagraph 1. who is a full-time salaried employee of a business which offers motor vehicles for rent or lease, may include lessees under a master contract providing coverage to the lessor or may transact excess motor vehicle liability insurance providing coverage in excess of the standard liability limits provided by the lessor in its lease to a person renting or leasing a motor vehicle from the licensee's employer for liability arising in connection with the negligent operation of the leased or rented motor vehicle, provided that the lease or rental agreement is for not more than 90 30 days; that the lessee is not provided coverage for more than 90 30 consecutive days per lease period, and, if the lease is extended beyond 90 30 days, the coverage may be extended one

 time only for a period not to exceed an additional 30 days; that the <u>business entity makes available information that</u> states that the <u>lessee's</u> lessee is given written notice that his or her personal insurance policy providing coverage on an owned motor vehicle may provide additional excess coverage; and that the purchase of the insurance is not required in connection with the lease or rental of a motor vehicle. The excess liability insurance may be provided to the lessee as an additional insured on a policy issued to the licensee's employer.

- 3. A business entity that office licensed pursuant to subparagraph 1., or a person licensed pursuant to subparagraph 1. who is a full-time salaried employee of a business which offers motor vehicles for rent or lease, may, as an agent of an insurer, transact insurance that provides coverage for the liability of the lessee to the lessor for damage to the leased or rented motor vehicle if:
- a. The lease or rental agreement is for not more than $\underline{90}$ 30 days; or the lessee is not provided coverage for more than $\underline{90}$ 30 consecutive days per lease period, but, if the lease is extended beyond $\underline{90}$ 30 days, the coverage may be extended one time only for a period not to exceed an additional 30 days; and
- b. The <u>business entity makes available information</u>
 that states that the <u>lessee's lessee is given written notice</u>
 that his or her personal insurance policy that provides
 coverage on an owned motor vehicle may provide such coverage
 with or without a deductible and that
