House Amendment 1 – 916463

II. Summary of Amendments Contained in Message:

House Amendment 1 makes the following provisions:

- Changes the relationship of The Office of Public Guardianship to the Department of Elderly Affairs (DOEA): the office would now come under the control of the DOEA.
- Directs that the Secretary of Elderly Affairs rather than the Governor appoint an executive director for the Statewide Public Guardianship Office who is a member of the Florida Bar and knowledgeable of guardianship law.
- Removes obsolete language pertaining to interim report requirements and requires that the
 executive director provide status reports and recommendations pertaining to public
 guardianship services to the Secretary by January 1, 2004 and by January 1 each year
 thereafter.
- Provides the Department of Elderly Affairs with the authority to adopt rules pursuant to ss. 120.536(1).
