Thereafter, 50 percent of the proceeds shall be distributed to 9 the Children's Home Society of Florida, which must distribute 10 11 the funds proportionately to each of its divisions, to be used for child abuse prevention programs. The other 50 percent of 12 13 the proceeds shall be distributed to the board of directors 14 of the Florida Network of Children's Advocacy Centers, Inc., 15 who shall develop funding criteria and an allocation 16 methodology that ensures an equitable distribution of those funds among network participant centers that meet the 17 standards set forth in s. 39.3035. The criteria and 18 19 methodologies shall take into account factors that include, 20 but need not be limited to, the center's accreditation status with respect to the National Children's Alliance, the number 21 2.2 of clients served, and the population of the area being served by the children's advocacy center. 23 (c) For the first 5 years in which the plate is 24 issued, a maximum of 20 percent of the fees collected may be 25 used for administrative costs directly associated with the 26 27 operation of the marketing and promotion of the plate. Ten 28 percent of the fees shall be allocated to the Children's Home 29 Society of Florida and 10 percent shall be allocated to the 30 Florida Network of Children's Advocacy Centers, Inc. Five 31 years after the date the first license plate is issued.
