A bill to be entitled

An act relating to career service exemptions; amending s. 110.205, F.S.; deleting positions related to the Correctional Educational Program within the Department of Corrections; deleting superintendent and assistant superintendent positions and adding the positions of colonel and major within the Department of Corrections; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraphs (d) and (m) of subsection (2) of section 110.205, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

110.205 Career service; exemptions.--

- (2) EXEMPT POSITIONS.--The exempt positions that are not covered by this part include the following:
- (d) All officers and employees of the state universities and the Correctional Education Program within the Department of Corrections, and the academic personnel and academic administrative personnel of the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind. In accordance with the provisions of s. 1002.36, the salaries for academic personnel and academic administrative personnel of the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind shall be set by the board of trustees for the school, subject only to the approval of the State Board of Education. The salaries for all instructional personnel and all administrative and noninstructional personnel of the Correctional Education Program shall be set by the Department of Corrections, subject to the approval of the Department of Management Services.

1 (m) All assistant division director, deputy division 2 director, and bureau chief positions in any department, and 3 those positions determined by the department to have managerial responsibilities comparable to such positions, 4 5 which positions include, but are not limited to, positions in 6 the Department of Health, the Department of Children and 7 Family Services, and the Department of Corrections that are 8 assigned primary duties of serving as the superintendent or 9 assistant superintendent, or warden, or assistant warden, 10 colonel, or major of an institution; positions in the 11 Department of Corrections that are assigned primary duties of serving as the circuit administrator or deputy circuit 12 13 administrator; positions in the Department of Transportation that are assigned primary duties of serving as regional toll 14 managers and managers of offices as defined in s. 15 20.23(3)(d)3. and (4)(d); positions in the Department of 16 17 Environmental Protection that are assigned the duty of an 18 Environmental Administrator or program administrator; and 19 positions in the Department of Health that are assigned the duties of Environmental Administrator, Assistant County Health 20 Department Director, and County Health Department Financial 21 Administrator. Unless otherwise fixed by law, the department 22 shall set the salary and benefits of these positions in 23 accordance with the rules established for the Selected Exempt 24 25 Service. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 26 27 law. 28 29 30
