22	(17) "Construction and demolition debris" means
23	discarded materials generally considered to be not
24	water-soluble and nonhazardous in nature, including, but not
25	limited to, steel, glass, brick, concrete, asphalt roofing
26	material, pipe, gypsum wallboard, and lumber, from the
27	construction or destruction of a structure as part of a
28	construction or demolition project or from the renovation of a
29	structure, and including rocks, soils, tree remains, trees,
30	and other vegetative matter that normally results from land
31	clearing or land development operations for a construction

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project, including such debris from construction of structures at a site remote from the construction or demolition project site. Mixing of construction and demolition debris with other types of solid waste will cause it to be classified as other than construction and demolition debris. The term also includes:

- (a) Clean cardboard, paper, plastic, wood, and metal scraps from a construction project;
- (b) Except as provided in s. 403.707(12)(j), unpainted, nontreated wood scraps from facilities manufacturing materials used for construction of structures or their components and unpainted, nontreated wood pallets provided the wood scraps and pallets are separated from other solid waste where generated and the generator of such wood scraps or pallets implements reasonable practices of the generating industry to minimize the commingling of wood scraps or pallets with other solid waste; and
- (c) Nonhazardous fiber reinforced cement scrap waste from facilities manufacturing fiber reinforced cement products for the construction industry provided the waste is separated from other solid waste where generated and the generator of such waste implements reasonable practices of the generating industry to minimize commingling of the fiber reinforced cement scrap waste with other solid waste; and

(d)(c) De minimis amounts of other nonhazardous wastes that are generated at construction or destruction projects, provided such amounts are consistent with best management practices of the industry.
