(1) The Governor may award a medal of heroism of appropriate design, with ribbons and appurtenances, 10 to law enforcement officers, corrections officers, or 11 12 correctional probation officers as defined in section 943.10(14), Florida Statutes, firefighters, as defined in 13 section 112.191(1)(b), Florida Statutes, emergency medical 14 technicians, as defined in section 401.23, Florida Statutes, 15 or paramedics, as defined in section 401.23, Florida Statutes, 16 17 who have distinguished themselves conspicuously by gallantry and intrepidity and have risked their lives deliberately, 18 19 above and beyond the call of duty, while: 20 (a) Performing duty in their respective positions; and (b) Engaging in hazardous or perilous activities to 21 22 preserve lives, with the knowledge that such activities might result in great personal harm to themselves. 23 (2) The candidates or persons seeking to nominate 24 25 candidates for the award must make written application to the Governor. The Governor may refer applications to the 26 27 Department of Law Enforcement, the Department of Community 28 Affairs, or to a private association for advice and recommendations regarding the applications. 29 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003. 31 1
