A bill to be entitled

An act relating to postsecondary student fees; amending s. 1009.21, F.S.; classifying certain nonresident aliens as residents for tuition purposes; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Paragraph (k) is added to subsection (10) of section 1009.21, Florida Statutes, to read:
- 1009.21 Determination of resident status for tuition purposes.—Students shall be classified as residents or nonresidents for the purpose of assessing tuition in community colleges and state universities.
- (10) The following persons shall be classified as residents for tuition purposes:
 - (k) Nonresident aliens who:
 - 1. Have resided in Florida for at least 2 years.
- 2. Have attended a State Board of Education approved Florida high school.
- 3. Have graduated from a State Board of Education approved Florida high school or have received a high school equivalency diploma in Florida.
- 4. Have filed an affidavit with a community college or a state university which states that the student has applied for legal immigrant status or will apply when the student becomes eligible for such application.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003.
