A bill to be entitled
An act relating to trust funds; creating the
Wildflower Trust Fund; providing for sources of
funds and purposes; providing for annual
carryforward of funds; providing for future
review and termination or re-creation of the
trust fund; providing a contingent effective
date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Wildflower Trust Fund.--

(1) The Wildflower Trust Fund is created within the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services. Funds shall be credited to the trust fund as provided in Senate Bill 666, to be used for the purposes set forth in that bill.

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 216.301, Florida Statutes, and pursuant to section 216.351, Florida Statutes, any balance in the trust fund at the end of any fiscal year must remain in the trust fund at the end of the year and must be made available for carrying out the purposes of the trust fund.

(3) In accordance with section 19(f)(2), Article III of the State Constitution, the trust fund must, unless terminated sooner, be terminated on July 1, 2007. Before its scheduled termination, the trust fund must be reviewed as provided in section 215.3206(1) and (2), Florida Statutes.

Section 2. This act shall take effect on the effective date of Senate Bill 666, but it shall not take effect unless it is enacted by a three-fifths vote of the membership of each
