election of district school board members in the general election of 2006. All five school board seats will be up for 2 3 reelection in the general election of 2006 and staggered from that date forward. If for any reason there is a countywide 4 5 election prior to the 2004 general election and 2004 6 primaries, the vote for this act will occur on the earlier 7 date. If it is prior to the qualifying period for the 2004 8 general election, all school board seats will be up for election in the year 2004 and staggered from that point 9 10 forward.

Section 2. In accordance with section 101.161, Florida Statutes, and section 1 of this act, the Supervisor of Elections of Lee County shall place the title and substance of the referendum on the ballot as follows:
