This bill allows any person, 60 years of age or older or a totally and permanently disabled American veteran meeting low income standards, to apply year round for a special lower rate, fee, rental, or other charge from the Florida Keys Aqueduct Authority.

The Authority currently takes applications between January and March of each year and the Authority desires to extend the application period for such programs throughout the year for certain qualified persons.

Section 1. Amends subsection (2) of section 14 of chapter 76-441, L.O.F., to allow year round any person, 60 years of age or older or a totally and permanently disabled American veteran meeting low income standards, to apply for a special lower rate, fee, rental, or other charge from the Authority.
