Section 1. (5) is added to section 627.7283, Florida
Statutes, to read:
627.7283 Cancellation; return of premium
(5) The insurer must refund 100 percent of the
unearned premium if the insured is a member of the United
States Armed Forces, whether an active or reserve member, who
cancels because he or she is called to active duty or
transferred by the United States Armed Forces to a location
where the insurance is not required. The insurer may require
a member of the United States Armed Forces to submit either a
copy of the official military orders or a written verification
signed by the member's commanding officer to support the
refund authorized under this subsection. If the insurer

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1	cancels, the insurer must refund 100 percent of the unearned
2	premium. Cancellation is without prejudice to any claim
3	originating prior to the effective date of the cancellation.
4	For purposes of this section, unearned premiums must be
5	computed on a pro rata basis.
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
