A resolution recognizing Goodwill Industries' contributions to Florida's citizens and its economy.

5 WHEREAS, founded in 1902, Goodwill Industries is the 6 largest nonprofit provider of employment and training services 7 in the nation, affording employment, job-training, and career-8 service opportunities to people with disabilities, as well as to 9 those with disadvantages such as welfare dependency, illiteracy, 10 criminal history, and homelessness, and

11 WHEREAS, during its 101-year existence, Goodwill has helped 12 millions of people through its programs and services, and, in 13 2002 alone, over 90,000 Floridians participated in the 14 employment and training offered by Goodwill and more than 20,000 15 obtained community employment, and

WHEREAS, the Florida Goodwill Association, comprised of nine Goodwill member organizations located throughout the state, collectively generated more than \$240 million in earnings for individuals placed in community employment, resulting in a significant contribution to the state's economic base and tax revenues, NOW, THEREFORE,
