(1) The Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund within the Department of Military Affairs, FLAIR number 23 62-2-719, which is to be terminated pursuant to Section 19(f), 24 25 Article III of the State Constitution on July 1, 2006, unless 26 terminated sooner by law, is terminated on November 4, 2004, 27 and re-created. 28 (2) All current balances of the trust fund are carried 29 forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund 30 are continued. 31
