24	engaging in any practice, tryout, workout, or other physical
25	activity associated with the student's candidacy for an

The 30 bylaws shall establish requirements for eliciting a student's 31 medical history and performing the medical evaluation required 32 under this paragraph, which shall include minimum standards for 33 the physical capabilities necessary for participation in 34 interscholastic athletic competition as contained in a uniform 35 preparticipation physical evaluation and history form. The 36 evaluation and history form shall incorporate the recommendation 37 of the American Heart Association for preparticipation 38 cardiovascular screening and shall provide a place for the 39 signature of the practitioner performing the evaluation with an 40 attestation that each examination procedure listed on the form 41 was performed by the practitioner or by someone under the direct 42 supervision of the practitioner. The form shall also contain a 43 place for the practitioner to indicate if a referral to another practitioner was made in lieu of completion of a certain 44 45 examination procedure. The form shall provide a place for the 46 practitioner to whom the student was referred to complete the 47 remaining sections and attest to that portion of the 48 examination. The preparticipation physical evaluation form shall 49 advise students to complete a cardiovascular assessment and 50 shall include information concerning alternative cardiovascular 51 evaluation and diagnostic tests. Practitioners administering 52 medical evaluations pursuant to this subsection must know the 53 minimum standards established by the organization and certify 54 that the student meets the standards. If the practitioner 55 determines that there are any abnormal findings in the 56 cardiovascular system, the student may not participate unless a 608953

Results of such medical evaluation must be 60 provided to the school.
