Remove lines 959-997, and insert:

(2) The sum of \$10 million from the General Revenue Fund to the entertainment industry financial incentive program created in s. 288.1254, Florida Statutes.

(3) The sum of \$10 million from the General Revenue Fund to the Quick Action Closing Fund created in s. 288.1088, Florida Statutes, all of which shall be used to fund projects in rural communities as defined in s. 288.0656(2)(b), Florida Statutes.

(4) The sum of \$15 million from the General Revenue Fund to the Rural Infrastructure Fund created in s. 288.0655, Florida Statutes.

(5) The sum of \$7.5 million from the General Revenue Fund for fixed capital outlay military base retention projects

52 the purpose of developing a plan to implement the convention
53 center sales tax rebate program as established in sections 5 and
