This legislation re-creates the Revolving Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2004. The Revolving Trust Fund, FLAIR #75-2-600, is administered by the Agency for Workforce Innovation. This fund was last re-created effective November 4, 2000, by Chapter 2000-71, Laws of Florida, in the Department of Labor and Employment Security.

This fund is used as a proprietary fund to support the agency's stockroom, print shop, mail services, building operations and other administrative activities.
