Paragraph (e) of subsection (2) of section 373.073, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 11 12 373.073 Governing board.--(2) Membership on governing boards shall be selected 13 from candidates who have significant experience in one or more 14 of the following areas, including, but not limited to: 15 agriculture, the development industry, local government, 16 17 government-owned or privately owned water utilities, law, civil engineering, environmental science, hydrology, 18 19 accounting, or financial businesses. Notwithstanding the 20 provisions of any other general or special law to the 21 contrary, vacancies in the governing boards of the water 22 management districts shall be filled according to the following residency requirements, representing areas 23 designated by the United States Water Resources Council in 24 25 United States Geological Survey, River Basin and Hydrological Unit Map of Florida--1975, Map Series No. 72: 26 27 (e) Southwest Florida Water Management District: 28 1. Two members shall reside in Hillsborough County. 2. One member shall reside in the area consisting of 29 30 Hillsborough and Pinellas Counties. 31 2.3. Two members shall reside in Pinellas County.

3	County.
